### UNAULA Miembro del Hub Latinoamericano y Caribeño de TIP

El pasado 29 de abril la Universidad Autónoma Latinoamericana firmó acuerdo con la Universidad de Sussex, de Inglaterra, para dar inicio al Hub Latinoamericano y Caribeño de TIP (Política de Innovación Transformativa). El objetivo del Hub es trabajar con ideas y métodos de política de innovación transformativa para desarrollar un nuevo enfoque de la política de ciencia, tecnología e innovación que permita enfrentar los desafíos sociales y ambientales de la región.

Nueve organizaciones de Colombia, México y Chile, Además de UNAULA, unirán sus esfuerzos para implementar metodologías de experimentación en política y evaluación formativa, desarrolladas por el Consorcio de Política de Innovación Transformativa (TIPC, por sus siglas en inglés). Ellas son, la Universidad del Rosario, el Centro de Ciencia y Tecnología de Antioquia, el Instituto Nacional de Cancerología – Empresa Social del Estado, el Centro Interdisciplinario de Estudios sobre Desarrollo – CIDER de la Universidad de los Andes, el Instituto Tecnológico Metropolitano – ITM, la Universidad del Valle, el Ministerio de Ciencia, Tecnología e Innovación de Colombia, la Universidad Iberoamericana de México y la Universidad de Talca en Chile.

Durante 18 meses, los esfuerzos de estas instituciones se enfocarán en la creación del laboratorio móvil de transformación, la ejecución de experimentos de política regional transformativa, y, por último, la coproducción de un libro explicativo del enfoque de la política transformativa y los estudios de caso de las instituciones participantes. A partir de estas actividades se espera consolidar el proceso de formulación e implementación de la política pública de innovación y apoyar de manera efectiva los procesos de cambio transformativo.

El HUBLAYCTIP es una comunidad de práctica autofinanciada con aportes de cada miembro y la metodología de trabajo es participativa y de aprendizaje colectivo a través de experimentos, webinars, mentoría y una conferencia de innovación transformativa y experimentación auspiciada por el Consorcio TIPC. El pasado 15 de abril, por ejemplo, se realizó el primer webinar de los “Tres marcos de Política de Innovación” que contó con la participación activa de más de 90 investigadores, profesores y hacedores de política vinculados al Hub. 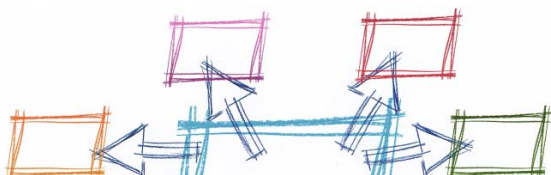

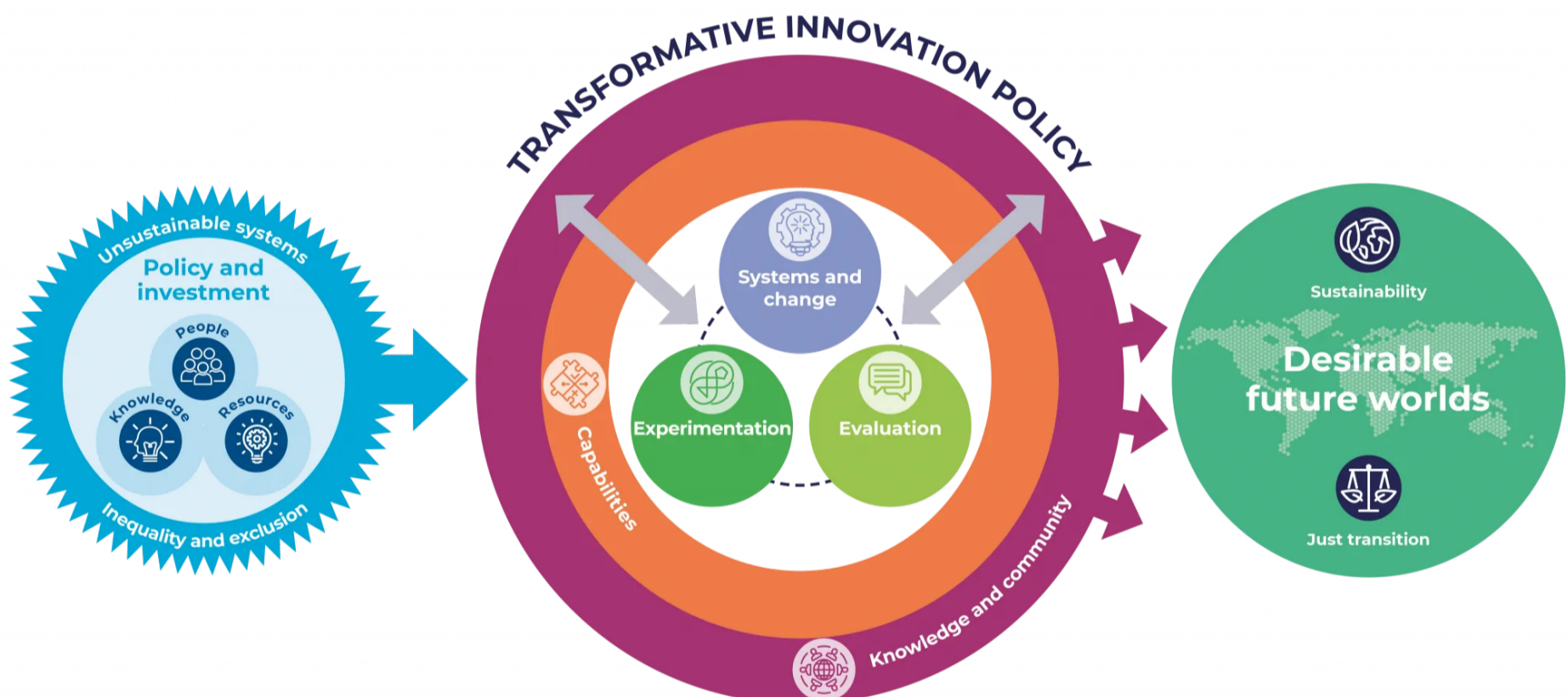
# ABOUT THE TRANSFORMATIVE INNOVATION POLICY CONSORTIUM

## WHAT IS TRANSFORMATIVE INNOVATION POLICY?

Transformative Innovation Policy (TIP) refers to a strategic and proactive approach to shaping innovation in ways that drive substantial and positive changes in society, the economy, and the environment. It goes beyond traditional innovation policies that focus solely on economic growth and technological advancements. TIP seeks to address complex societal challenges, promote sustainability, and foster inclusive development by encouraging innovation that leads to socio-technical system change.

Key characteristics of Transformative Innovation Policy include:

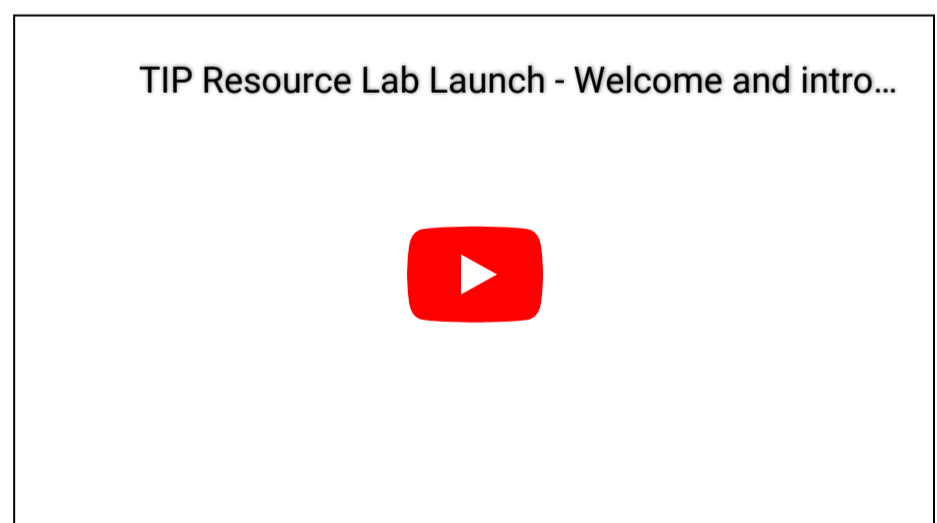
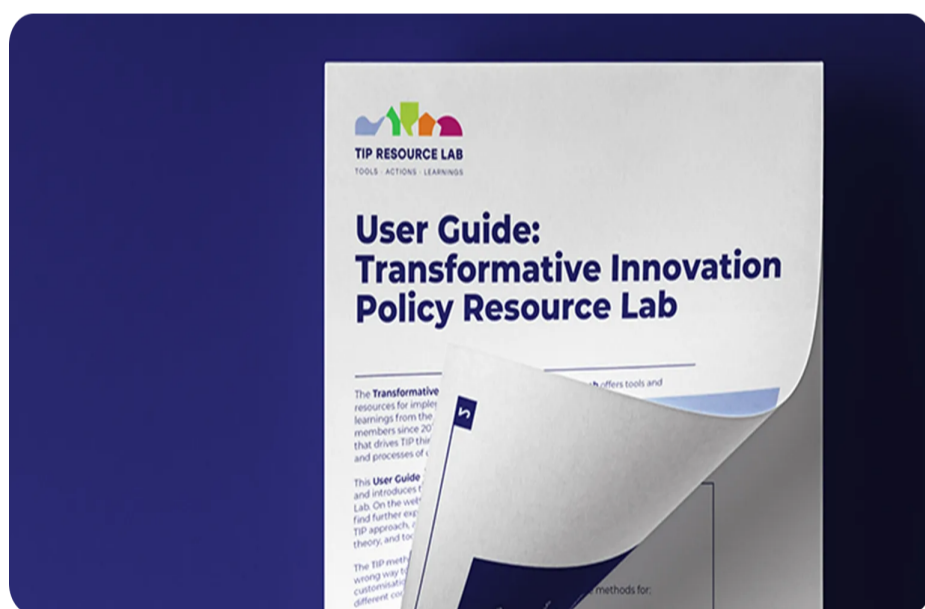
- **Societal impact:** TIP aims to create innovations that address pressing social and environmental challenges, such as climate change, growing global inequality and biodiversity loss. But also access to healthcare, food and water.
- **Systems approach:** Instead of focusing on individual technologies or sectors, TIP takes a holistic view, considering the interplay between various elements within socio-technical systems.
- **Long-term vision:** TIP looks beyond short-term gains and considers the long-term impacts of innovation on society, seeking to create lasting positive changes.
- **Multi-stakeholder collaboration:** TIP involves collaboration among policymakers, researchers, industries, communities, and civil society to co-create innovative solutions.
- **Experimentation:** TIP encourages trying out new approaches, methods, and interventions through experiments to learn what works best in achieving transformative outcomes.
- **Diverse perspectives:** TIP incorporates a range of perspectives, including social, economic, environmental, and ethical considerations, to ensure that innovation benefits a wide range of stakeholders.
- **Equity and inclusion:** TIP strives to ensure that the benefits of innovation are accessible and equitable for all segments of society, including marginalised communities.
- **Learning and adaptation:** TIP involves a continuous learning process, where insights gained from experiments and feedback loops inform policy adjustments as well as the TIP approach itself.

In essence, Transformative Innovation Policy seeks to harness the power of innovation to address global challenges and drive positive transformations. It moves beyond incremental improvements and aims to reshape entire systems to create a more sustainable, equitable, and prosperous future.

## RESEARCH

At the heart of TIPC is transformative research: Research informed by policy and policy informed by research. Transformative research is co-created with practitioners, policymakers and other stakeholders so that interventions become informed by evidence, and developed through live implementation and experimentation. Evidence and knowledge is co-produced by many voices. This unlocks a wider policy perspective and enables reflection and learning which ultimately contributes to transformation in systems to meet the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The three pillars of research, [experimentation](#) y [aprendizaje](#) form the foundation of TIPC.

## SYSTEMS THINKING IN TRANSFORMATIVE INNOVATION POLICY

Grounded in sustainability transitions research, Transformative Innovation Policy (TIP) thinking contends that to solve the severe and complex social and environmental challenges of our time, we need a 'systemic' understanding of society. This entails considering the interconnectedness of various components and actors within an innovation ecosystem as well as the realisation that innovation does not happen in isolation.

Socio-technical systems are characterised by the interaction between people, technology, and the larger social context in which they operate. They involve technical components (like tools, machines, processes) but also the human aspect (such as people's behaviours, consumption patterns, rules, values).

Examples of socio-technical-systems include the food, mobility, healthcare and energy system. To achieve a long-term transition towards sustainability, the interplay between technological infrastructures and human behaviours is essential. For instance, the long-term impact of alternative energy solutions can be influenced by investments, regulations, consumer demands and policy incentives but also external factors, such as floods or droughts, which might change peoples' mindsets.

Developing a transformative theory of change for socio-technical systems is the crucial first step in the TIPC methodology, as it identifies potential synergies, unintended consequences and leverage points, which ultimately contributes to creating more effective and sustainable innovation strategies. [Component 1 of the TIP Resource Lab](#) provides guidance for adopting systemic thinking and tools and practical examples for developing transformative theories of change.



## THE THREE FRAMES OF INNOVATION



Over the last decades two conceptual frameworks (Frame 1 and 2) have dominated the development of innovation policy-making which has been based on the 20th century supply-driven innovation model. This model takes the competition between nations and support for research and development (R&D) as the main entry point for policy making.

Both frames assume that economic growth is always positive. However, through this assumption, the many unintended consequences of science and technology are being ignored, for instance, development that has adversely impacted society and the environment, such as mass consumption, excessive waste production or the growing dependency on fossil fuels.

A third frame, Transformative Innovation Policy (TIP), is emerging – one that places social and environmental problems at the core. TIPC's cornerstone research papers build and elaborate on this framework.

## CORNERSTONE RESEARCH PAPERS

The following three research papers can be described as 'cornerstone': they form the theoretical background for Transformative Innovation Policy, and set out principles that underpin the core TIPC approach.

1. The first, by Johan Schot and Ed Steinmueller, introduces 'Three Frames' for innovation policy: R&D, systems of innovation and transformative change.

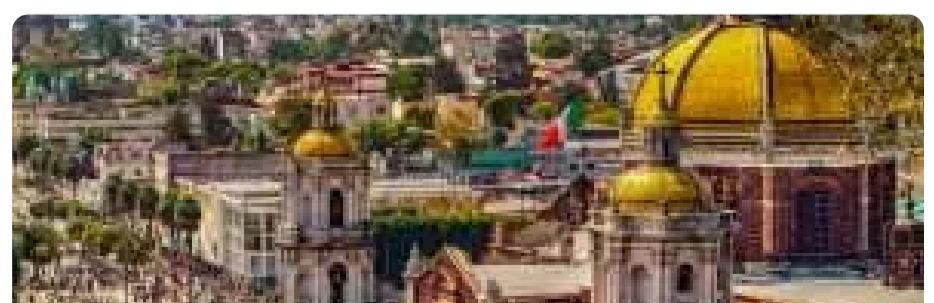
